



Order Below Exh.1 In R.C.S.No.76/2023
(Rajaram Gopal Ghunke v. Sadhana Gajanan
Nalawade and Ors.)

On perusal of record and proceeding it appears that, present suit came to be filed on 20.04.2023. The suit proceeded ex-parte against defendant Nos.1 to 4. During pendency of the suit, the plaintiff has deleted name of defendant No.12 as per order passed below Exh.76. The suit is pending for filing of amended copies of the plaint since 03.01.2025. It appears that, in spite of ample opportunities being given, the plaintiff failed to take proper and effective steps to proceed further. The suit is stale and ineffective since 22.08.2025. Hence, as per order passed below Exh.1 dated 30.01.2026 and 25.03.2026, the suit came to be posted for dismissal order. Thereafter also, ample opportunities have been given to the plaintiff on 01.04.2026, 21.04.2026 and 10.06.2026 to take proper and effective steps to proceed further. However, the plaintiff and his learned advocate remained absent on above mentioned dates and failed to take proper and effective steps to proceed further. Today also, the plaintiff and his learned advocate are absent when called out repeatedly. The suit is more than three years old and it is stale and ineffective since 22.08.2025. Hence, it shows that, the plaintiff is not interested to proceed further. In view of above peculiar facts and circumstances, no purpose will be served by keeping pending present stale and ineffective suit. Resultantly, I pass following order :-

:: ORDER ::

The suit is dismissed in default of the plaintiff.
