



**ORDER BELOW EXH.01 IN R.C.S.NO.91/2023**  
**[Sagar Annasaheb Mali v. Aannappa @ Aannasaheb**  
**Rumanna Mali And Ors.]**

The plaintiff, defendants and their learned advocates are present before the Court. In view of report (Exh.55) of the learned trained mediator advocate and compromise pursis (Exh.56), it shows that, the matter is amicably settled in mediation between the parties as per terms and conditions mentioned in compromise pursis (Exh.56). Both the parties have voluntarily admitted correctness of contents of compromise pursis (Exh.56). Hence, compromise pursis (Exh.56) came to be read and recorded. Both the parties and their learned advocates have prayed that, the suit may be decreed as per compromise pursis (Exh.56).

02. Considering aforesaid facts and submissions of both parties and their learned advocates, it will be just and proper to decree the suit as per compromise pursis (Exh.56). Resultantly, I pass following order :

**:: ORDER ::**

1. The suit is decreed in terms of compromise pursis (Exh.56).
2. Decree be drawn in terms of compromise pursis (Exh.56), which shall form part of the decree.
3. Court-fees be refunded as per rule.
