02. Plaintiff submitted that, vide order below Exh.44 plaintiff brought on record the legal heirs of deceased defendant No.1. Thereafter, defendant No.1(a) died. Accordingly, plaintiff has filed death certificate of deceased. Now, plaintiff wants to indicate the death of defendant No.1(a) by mentioning word 'deceased' against his name.
