



ORDER BELOW EXH. NO. 01 IN CRI.M.A.NO.59/2024
(Ibrahim Jamadar v. Heena Mahat)

On perusal of record and proceeding it appears that, present complaint has been initially filed by complainant Nos.1 to 3. During pendency of the complaint, complainants amended the complaint and thereby deleted names of complainant Nos.2 and 3. Hence, present complaint is proceed by complainant No.1 alone. Since 23.06.2025, the complaint is pending for filing of amended copy of the complaint. In spite of ample opportunities being given, the complainant failed to filed on record amended copy of the complaint. Hence, as per order passed below Exh.1, dated 04.04.2026, the complaint is posted for dismissal order. Thereafter also, ample opportunities have been given to the complainant on 09.04.2026, 02.05.2026, 14.05.2026 and 20.06.2026 to take proper and effective steps to proceed further. However, the complainant and his learned advocate failed to take proper and effective steps to proceed further on above mentioned dates. Today, the complainant and his learned advocate are absent today when called out repeatedly. The complaint is more than one and half years old and it is stale and ineffective since 23.06.2025. However, it shows that, the complainant is not interested to proceed further. In view of above facts and circumstances, no fruitful purpose will be served by keeping pending stale and ineffective complaint. Resultantly, I pass following order :—

:: ORDER ::

The complaint is dismissed in default for want of prosecution by the complainant.
