

Angrej Singh Vs Dharminder Singh 111-2017

JDs No.1 to 3 ex parte vide order dated 07.12.2018.

Warrants of possession received back unexecuted with the report that warrants were obstructed regarding property A mentioned in the execution by JD Pal Singh and as such, there is apprehension of some dispute taking place at the spot. It is further reported that police help be provided to execute the warrants with regard to the property A. Further, it is reported that property B is already sealed by Punjab and Sind Bank, Sector 42, Chandigarh and as such warrant of possession could not be executed at the spot. Learned counsel for decree holder submitted that warrant of possession be executed for the time being qua property A and he also wants to move an application for police help to execute the warrant of possession qua property A. File be accordingly put up on 16.03.2019 for further proceedings.
