Defendant No.1 has filed the present application for setting aside No W. S order passed against her.

2. The plaintiff has filed her say overleaf of application and strongly opposed the application.

3. Heard both the sides. Perused the record. It appears that the plaintiff has filed present suit for the relief of partition, perpetual injunction and declaration. The subject matter of the present suit is immovable properties. The valuable rights of defendant No.1 are involved in it. If the suit is proceeded without W.S and say of defendant No.1, then it would cause prejudice to her rights. Considering the above said discussion, I am of the view that No. W. S and No Say order passed against defendant No.1 is to be set aside. For delay, costs of Rs.700/- is to be saddled upon defendant No.1. In the result, I pass following order.
