


<u>MHKO190003042019</u> 	<u>ORDER BELOW EXH.25</u> <u>IN</u> <u>R.C.S. No. 58/2019</u> (Nasruddin Babalal Mulla Vs Anwar Imam Mullani etc. 3) (DATE: 16/07/2025)

This is an application filed by the plaintiff seeking for amendment in plaint under Order VI Rule 17 of Code of Civil Procedure (in-short C.P.C.).

2. The plaintiff submitted that the suit is instituted for declaration and permanent injunction. He submitted that due to typographical error registered document No.220/2018 is mentioned instead of registered document No.220/2012. He prayed to allow the application.

3. Defendants vide their say on the overleaf of the application, submitted that the application is filed after 6 years of institution of suit. Exh.5 has been already decided. Accordingly, he submitted to allow the application subject to costs of Rs.500/-.

4. Perused the record. Heard Ld. Advocate for defendants. Considered the submissions.

5. The amendments sought would not change the nature of the suit. The trial has not yet commenced. Further, the proposed

amendments would not prejudice the defendants. The amendments sought are due to typographical error and due to loss of sight. Hence, the application deserves to be allowed. Hence, the following order :

ORDER

1.	Application (Exh.25) is allowed.
2.	The plaintiff shall carry out the amendments in the plaint on or before next date.
3.	No order as to costs.
