CHARGE

I, R. D. Shinde, Judicial Magistrate First Class, Radhanagari, do hereby charge you;

Vishnu @ Sanjay Dinkar Parte
Age:55 years. Occ. Agri & Service
R/o: Turambe, Tal. Radhanagari,
Dist. Kolhapur

as follows;

That you accused on 25/03/2022 at about 07.45 a.m at Turambe, Tal. Radhanagari, Dist. Kolhapur, assaulted on the head and forehead of the informant Rajendra Shankar Bhavke by means of Spanner and Iron Rod which are instruments used as a weapon of offence likely to cause death and that you have thereby committed an offence punishable under Section 324 of the Indian Penal Code and within cognizance of this Court.

Secondly, that you accused on aforesaid date, time and place, intentionally insulted the above named informant by abusing him and thereby gave provocation to him intending or knowing it to be likely that such provocation will cause him to break public peace or commit any other offence, and thereby committed an offence punishable under Section 504 of the Indian Penal Code and within cognizance of this Court.

Thirdly, that you accused on aforesaid date, time and place, committed criminal intimidation by threat to kill the informant with intent to cause alarm to him and that you have thereby committed an offence punishable under Section 506(ii) of Indian Penal Code and within cognizance of this Court.

Fourthly, that you accused on aforesaid date, time and place, even after knowing that the informant is disabled person by his left hand, assaulted him or used force to him with intent to cause hurt to him and that you have thereby committed an offence punishable under Section 92(a)(b) of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act,2016 and within cognizance of this Court.

And, I hereby direct that you be tried by this Court on the above charge.
