ORDER BELOW EXH.1 IN M.A.C.P MA (FDR) MA No.18/2026
Anita & Ors. Vs. Layak & Ors.

This is an application filed by the applicants for release of FDR kept as per award passed in MACP No.46/2016.

2. It is case of applicants that at the time of passing of Award the motor accident claims tribunal has directed to deposit the compensation awarded to the applicant No.1 in fixed deposit for the period of five years. Now, the period of FDR is expired and applicant No.1 for his daily needs she required the amount deposited in fixed deposits.

3. In view of the application the report of Assistant Superintendent was called. Perused the report of Assistant Superintendent, Cash and Finance Department District Court, Latur and of Assistant Superintendent, District Court, Latur. Their report shows that no appeal is preferred against M.A.C.P No.46/2016 and an amount of Rs.3,00,000/- is deposited in the fixed deposit at Indian Overseas Bank, Branch-Chitikiran Complex, in front of Tahsil, Latur. Upon perusal of the documents produced along with the application below list Exh.4, it is observed that the compensation awarded to applicant No.1 has been deposited in a fixed deposit for a period of five years. Now, the period of FDR is expired. So also, for her daily needs she require the amount

deposited in fixed deposit. Accordingly, following order is passed.

ORDER

1. The application is allowed.
2. The Nazir of Motor Accident Claim Tribunal, Latur is directed to release the FDR No.0551176 in the name of applicant No.1 upon her identification.
