ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT NO.4

Perused application. This application has been filed for interim bail during pendency of the regular bail application. According to advocate for applicant, the applicant has not committed alleged offence. He has been falsely implicated. On perusal of F.I.R. it can be seen that the allegations against present applicant are that he beat the informant with kicks and fists. No weapon has been used by applicant in the given crime. Nothing is recovered from him pertaining the offence.

2) Further according to advocate for applicant the applicant is a student. He is appearing for the ongoing H.S.C. exam. He has already appeared in the exam of 05 subjects and exam of 02 subjects is remaining which is scheduled on 09.03.2026 and 11.03.2026. If the applicant is not able to appear for the exam on the given dates his entire academic year will be spoiled. The applicant is in M.C.R. and is not required for the purpose of interrogation. He is not a history sheeter or a previous convict. He is ready to abide by all terms and conditions subject to which interim bail is granted to him. He prayed that application be allowed.

3) Instant application has been strongly opposed by the A.G.P. for state on the ground that serious charges are alleged

against the applicant. Further that the applicant played active role in the commission of given crime. If he is released on bail he may abscond. Offence is committed recently, hence release of accused on interim bail at this stage would not be justified. He may be permitted to appear for the exam under police security by making the applicant deposit necessary charges. He prayed that application be rejected.

4) Heard both sides. Perused the document filed on record. The offences registered against the applicant are under Section 309 (6), 311, 352 of B.N.S. and Section 4, 25 of Arms Act. The said offences are serious, however if the role of applicant in the present crime is seen, the F.I.R. reflects that he beat the informant only with kick and fists. There are no other allegations against him. There is no recovery of weapon or cash amount from applicant pertaining to the crime.

5) The contention of applicant that he is a student and is appearing for the ongoing H.S.C. exam is supported by his examination identity card. As per submission of advocate for applicant, the applicant is not a history sheeter. The applicant is in judicial custody. He is not required for the purpose of investigation. If application for interim bail is rejected the applicant will lose his academic year which will be a big loss to him. He appears to be local resident of Latur and is ready to abide by all terms and conditions subject to which interim bail is granted to him. Hence, it would be justified to allow this

application subject to conditions. Therefore the following order :

ORDER

- 1) The application for interim bail filed by applicant is allowed.
- 2) The applicant/ accused namely Aniket Pradip Raut be released on temporary bail from 06.03.2026 to 12.00 noon of 12.03.2026 on executing the PR bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rs.Twenty five Thousand only) with one or two local solvent sureties, in the like amount surety of like amount in Crime No.94/2026 registered with Shivaji Nagar Police Station, Latur for the offences punishable under Sect. 309(6), 311, 352 of B.N.S., and Section 04, 25 of Arms Act.
- 3) The applicant shall not pressurize the witnesses or tamper with the prosecution evidence, in any manner.
- 4) The applicant shall submit on record copy of Aadhar card, detailed address and phone numbers of himself and of two of his near relatives as per Criminal Manual Chapter-I, Para 12(1).
- 5) The applicant shall surrender himself before the concerned Judicial Magistrate by 12.00

noon of 12.03.2026. After surrender the concerned Magistrate shall take the applicant in judicial custody.

- 6) In case of breach of any of the above conditions by the applicant, it is open for the prosecution to move this Court seeking cancellation of bail.
- 7) Bail before concerned Judicial Magistrate.
