**ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT NO.1**

Perused application. This application has been filed for regular bail. According to advocate for applicant, the applicant has not committed alleged offence. He has been falsely implicated. On perusal of F.I.R. it can be seen that the allegations against present applicant are that he assaulted the informant with a chopper and snatched Rs.8,000/- from him. However, there is no recovery of weapon or the said amount from his possession. Also there is no injury to the informant. This creates doubt on the contents of FIR.

2) Further according to advocate for applicant the

applicant is a student. The informant was known to the applicant. Because of certain exchange of words between them, the informant lodged FIR. Applicant is in M.C.R. and is not required for the purpose of interrogation. He is not a previous convict. He is ready to abide by all terms and conditions subject to which bail is granted to him. He prayed that application be allowed.

3) Instant application has been strongly opposed by the A.G.P. for state on the ground that serious charges are alleged against the applicant. Further that the applicant played active role in the commission of given crime. Before commission of offence he was carrying chopper with him which shows his preparation and motive to commit the alleged offence. The applicant is of criminal mentality. As many as 08 crimes have been registered against him in the past. If he is released on bail he may abscond. Also he is likely to threaten the witnesses. Offence is committed recently, hence release of accused on bail at this stage would not be justified. He prayed that application be rejected.

4) Heard both sides. Perused the document filed on record. The offence registered against the applicant are under Section 309 (6), 311, 352 of B.N.S. and Section 4, 25 of Arms Act. The said offence are serious, however there is no prima facie evidence to justify the contents of FIR. It is alleged in FIR that applicant assaulted the informant with chopper and

snatched him of Rs.8,000/-. However, there is no recovery of weapon or cash amount from possession of the applicant. The informant did not sustain any injury.

5) It appears from the say of prosecution that as many as 08 crime numbers have been registered against applicant in the past but just because there are 08 crimes registered against him the merits of present matter cannot be ignored. He is not a previous convict.

6. The applicant is in judicial custody. He is not required for the purpose of investigation. He appears to be local resident of Latur and is ready to abide by all terms and conditions subject to which bail is granted to him. Hence, it would be justified to allow this application subject to conditions. Therefore the following order :

#### **ORDER**

- 1) The application for regular bail is allowed.
- 2) The applicant/ accused namely Omprasad @ Ravi s/o. Pradip Kasbe be released on bail on executing the PR bond of Rs.25,000/- ( In words rupees Twenty five Thousand only) with one or two solvent sureties, in the like amount surety of like amount in Crime No. 94/2026 registered with Shivaji Nagar Police Station, Latur for the offences punishable

under Sect. 309(6), 311, 352 of B.N.S., and Section 04, 25 of Arms Act.

- 3) The applicant shall not pressurize the witnesses or tamper with the prosecution evidence, in any manner.
- 4) The applicant shall submit on record copy of Aadhar card, detailed address and phone numbers of himself and of two of his near relatives as per Criminal Manual Chapter-I, Para 12(1).
- 5) In case of breach of any of the above conditions by the applicant, it is open for the prosecution to move this Court seeking cancellation of bail.
- 6) Bail before concerned Judicial Magistrate.
