



Order below Exh. 01 in Cri.M.A( T.P) No. 59/2026  
( Rahul Vs. Subhash )  
(CNR NO. MHLA010016272026)

01. Applicant has filed present application to transfer cases pending before the different Court to any one court. Heard learned Adv. S.J.Sarwade for applicant. None present for non-applicant, hence no say order has been passed against him.

02. It is the contention of applicant that he has filed complaint bearing SCC No. 415/2021, SCC No. 1345/2021 under Section 138 of Negotiable Instrument's Act and RCC No. 1321/2022 under Sections 379, 420, 426, 427 and 468 of Indian Penal Code, in which complainant and accused are the same and they are also inter-related, but the matters are pending in two different courts and hence, the cases may be decided by sending in one court.

03. On perusal of record, it appears that applicant has filed two cases under Section 138 of Negotiable Instrument's Act, vide SCC No. 415/2021 and 1345/2021, which are now pending in the Additional C.J.M., Latur (Court No. 9), Latur and RCC No. 1321/2022, which is pending before 6<sup>th</sup> Additional C.J.M., Latur, in which complainant and accused are same and they are inter-related.

04. Considering the nature of matter, it appears that it would be convenient for both the parties to proceed with the

matter in one Court and no prejudice will be caused to non-applicants, if these cases are tried by one Court. Moreover, it is necessary to transfer the cases in any one Court to avoid conflict decisions. Considering, all the facts and circumstances, case is made out to transfer the cases in one court. Therefore, I proceed to pass following order :

**ORDER**

1. Application is allowed.
2. S.C.C. No. 415/2021 and S.C.C.1345/2021 are pending with 9<sup>th</sup> Additional C.J.M.Latur, is hereby withdrawn and transferred to 6<sup>th</sup> Additional C.J.M. Latur, where R.C.C. No. 1321/2022 is pending, for trial and disposal in accordance with law.
3. Inform to the concerned courts, accordingly.
