

**Further examination-in-chief of CW-2 by Adv.Shri.S.K. Sayed**

3. Claimant Vijay Swami was working in my Mobile Shoppy for 15 years prior to the accident. I had issued salary certificates to him. Now salary certificate produced on record at Sr.No.13 with list Exh.4 shown to me is issued by the manager of my mobile shoppy. It bears signature of the manager, its contents are true and correct and it is marked at **Exh. 51**.

**Cross-exam for Respondent No.2 by Adv. Shri.S.G. Diwan**

4. Financial turnover of my mobile shoppy is Rs.50 lakhs per month. I do not maintain the register of workers regarding their duty timings. I maintain account register of my mobile shoppy. Record of salary of workers of my mobile shoppy is maintained, but figures shown in it are not actual. Today I have not brought any record to show the salary of workers in my shoppy. I do not obtain signatures of workers on any register about receipt of salary. It is true to say that my business is running on two types of accounts to evade tax. It is not true to say that claimant Vijaykumar was never working in my mobile shoppy and I never gave salary of Rs.25,000/- per month to him. It is not true to say that to help the claimant today I am deposing false. It is not true to say that contents of my affidavit of examination-in-chief are false.
