ORDER BELOW APPLICATION EXH.4

1. The appellant has preferred this appeal challenging the Judgment and order of learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Chakur whereby the appellant was convicted for the offence punishable under Section 324 and 506 of the IPC for the period of three months and to pay a fine of Rs.4,000/-.

2. The Trial Court has also suspended the order of sentence on depositing the amount of fine.

3. The present application is filed submitting that the learned Trial Court has committed an error in convicting the accused and it is submitted that offences are bailable and Trial Court has suspended the sentence till the appeal period. It is submitted that appellant has every hope to success in appeal. Considering the submission and the affidavit of applicant the execution of the sentence deserves to be suspended and hence order.
