

Deposition of Witness No.09 for the prosecution.

I do hereby on solemn affirmation state that :

Examination-in-chief : by Shri. V.V. Deshpande, APP for the State.

1. Injured Vishwajeet Bhise was brought by Mohan Bhise to our hospital having history of attack with knife at farm on 03.06.2019 at around 8.00 to 8.30 pm. He was admitted in our hospital at 10.30 pm. I sent MLC to the Shivaji Nagar Police Station, Latur, which now shown to me bears my signature and contents in it is true and correct and it is at **Ext.149**.

2. I received the letter of police regarding fitness of the injured for recording statement which at page No.19 now shown to me bears my endorsement, accordingly contents is true and correct and it is at **Ext.150**. The police recorded statement of injured Vishwajeet at page No.20 now shown to me bears my endorsement with my signature.

3. Upon examination, I found the following injuries :
(1) Deep penetrating stab injury on right hypochondrium, 4 x 3 x 12 cm. Grievous in nature and fresh. Caused with sharp and pointed object like knife. It was dangerous to life injury. (2)

Right haemothorax and partial atelectasis of right lung. It was fresh injury. It was grievous and caused with pointed object like knife. It was dangerous to life injury. Accordingly, I issued the injury certificate with my signature which at page No.22 now shown to me bears my signature and contents in it is true and correct and it is at **Ext.151**.

4. The knife at M.O./P-1 now shown to me would cause the injuries I examined.

Cross-examination : by Shri. K.T. Jamdar, Adv. for the accused.

5. It is correct that the liver is situated mostly in right hypochondrium region. The thickness of liver will be normally 10 to 12 cm, depending upon the health of patient. It is correct that beneath the skin in the said area will be abdominal wall muscles. It is correct that the space in between two ribs is narrow. It is incorrect that the measurement of injury No.1 was carried out by CT scan. I volunteer that it was clinically measured. It is correct that there would be minute difference in between those two measurements. The said measurement was taken during the surgery.

6. I did not find any injury to any of the ribs of injured. The stab went to right hypochondrium, towards thorax in upward direction. It went by passing the liver in upward direction. It is incorrect that the exact source of haemothorax could not be told. I examined the blood pressure of the injured which was stable.

7. I was not shown the incriminating weapon. It is incorrect that the knife would generally inflict puncture injury in 1-2 cm depth. It is correct that the sharp object would have the flatten width. It is correct that partial atelectasis does not mean cut to the lungs. I am a neurosurgeon. It is incorrect that the injury to hypochondrium area is beyond my expertization. It is incorrect that I mentioned those injuries as instructed by Dr. Shivaji Bhise. I did not find any blunt injury at the entry point which would be caused with the metal grip of the knife shown to me. It is incorrect that I have deposed falsely my examination-in-chief now read over to me.
