ORDER BELOW EXH.12

The present application is placed by accused/applicant Karan Piraji Gaikwad for regular bail, who is involved in Crime No.494/2025 registered with Ahmedpur police station, District Latur, for the offence punishable under Sections 64(2)(m), 115(2), 352, 351(2)(3) of Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

2) **Brief facts of the case are as under :**

According to the allegations set forth in charge-sheet accused/applicant in between 11.06.2024 to 25.06.2025 committed repeated rape upon victim woman aged about 35 years. Further, he has removed her clothes and made video of victim person. Accused applicant threaten to cause death of victim as well as threaten to publish or transmit alleged video in electronic form when she refused for forcible sexual activity. Charge-sheet is came to be filed. Accused is arrested on 11.12.2025. He is in judicial custody.

3) Learned Advocate for the accused submits that, accused has not committed any offence. Accused is younger in age then victim woman even if we accepted the case of prosecution as it is then also amounts to consensual relationship. The Investigation Officer has not collected evidence in regard to the recording of video as alleged by the victim. Charge-sheet is came to be filed. Substantial time is required for the completion of trial. Hence, he claimed for bail.

4) Learned APP for the State submits that, accused has committed serious crime against helpless woman. There is sufficient

evidence on record to infer commission of crime by accused. Hence, claim for rejection of bail.

5) The evidence on record indicates that, the commission of alleged rape continued for a long period of one year. Further, it indicates that, the commission of rape is made at Ahmedpur then at Pune then again accused kept victim in rented room at Ahmedpur. These circumstances requires deeper consideration whether it is a case of sexual assault or rape or whether it is a consensual relationship in between accused and victim. Victim is a older than accused by seven years. Considering the facts and circumstances of this case, grounds are made out to grant regular bail. Hence, following order.

ORDER

- 1) The application is allowed.
- 2) The applicant/accused Karan Piraji Gaikwad, R/o. Kalegaon Tq. Ahmedpur, Dist. Latur be released on bail on execution of personal bond in sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) with surety in the like amount.
- 3) Accused/applicant shall not enter in the village Kalegaon Tq. Ahmedpur till disposal of the case.
