Ranjana Vs. Shivdas and others

:: ORDER BELOW EXH.46 ::

01. The application is submitted by the J.D. Shivdas. According to him, he has challenged the order passed below Exh.28 of this court before the Hon'ble High Court and by that time further order may not be passed and further prayed to adjourn the matter.

02. The application is objected by the D.H.

03. The order is passed below Exh.28 on 18/12/2025 to appoint a receiver. Accordingly, the receiver has done the necessary job assigned to him and has submitted his report before this court. The crop of Toor is deposited with the warehouse at Shirur-Tajband on 11/01/2026. The J.D. had every right to challenge the order of this court, which he has challenged before the Hon'ble High Court. But, there is no document in support of the submissions. The Ld. Advocate for the J.D. submitted that, writ petition is pending with regard to this particular darkhast before the Hon'ble High Court.

04. Relied upon submissions of the Ld. Advocate for the J.D., if it is believed that, the writ petition is pending, then also the J.D. was given opportunity on 20/02/2026 to bring orders from the Hon'ble High Court. The order dated 20/02/2026 below Exh.45 is self speaking and so application below Exh.46 does not survive as against order passed below Exh.45. Hence, the application is rejected.
