

**ORDER BELOW EXH.1**

Perused the application. It reveals that it has been filed for getting Heirship Certificate vide section 2 of the Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827. Thus, the citation notice and proclamation needs to be ordered to be issued. Hence, said notice be affixed on the notice board of concerned authorities and of this Court. Further, issue proclamation in the form contained in Appendix A on process fee inviting all persons who dispute the right of the applicants to appear in the Court within one month from the date of the proclamation and enter their objection (if any) and declaring that if no sufficient objection is offered, the Court will proceed to receive proof of the right of the applicant, and if satisfied grant them a certificate of heirship.
