ORDER BELOW EXH.1.

The instant matter is kept before the Rashtriya Lok Nyayalaya scheduled on today itself. Both parties along with their respective Advocates appeared before the Panel. The parties have been identified by their respective Advocates. The parties have filed joint compromise memo (Exh.9) and thereby informed that their property dispute has amicably been settled before the Lok Nyayalaya.

Perusal of the record reveals that, the instant suit is brought seeking for partition and separate possession. However, during mediation process the defendants have expressly sought for their respective shares. Further I have personally seen while the plaintiff pressing the shoulder of defendant No. 2, while she was seeking her share. Thus, i am satisfied that the plaintiffs are under coercion and under the garb of giving their share, the defendants have been brought here and taken their signatures on compromise memo. In such circumstances, the terms of compromise by any stretch of imagination, cannot be said to be lawful and legally executable. Thus, the compromise needs to be rejected. Hence, rejected. Order accordingly.
