This date is fixed for production of the Child Allegedly in Conflict with Law, hearing of argument and delivery of judgment.

Ordered

that, on inquiry before the Board, the child allegedly in conflict with law Samir Sekh is found to be *not* in conflict with law and is accordingly acquitted of the offense punishable under section 14, Foreigners Act, in terms of Section 17(1) of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015. Dealing Assistant is hereby directed to undertake necessary steps to transfer, in sealed envelope, the matters regarding the child to the Child Welfare Committee, North 24 Parganas with the details required in Form 17 of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Rules, 2017. The Child Welfare Committee, North 24 Parganas is directed under section 17(2) of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015 to undertake necessary steps for care, custody, treatment, education, training, development, social reintegration and rehabilitation of the child. Superintendent, Dhrubashram Observation Home is directed to undertake necessary steps for the production of the child Samir Sekh before the Child Welfare Committee, North 24 Parganas, within 24 Hours of receipt of this order, in terms of section 31 of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015 read with Rules 18 and 19 of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Rules, 2017. Dealing Assistant is further directed to update germane registers & Case Information System, furnish a copy of this order to the child Samir Sekh and forward copies of the judgment and final order to the following authorities, forthwith, in sealed envelope:

1. Chairman, Child Welfare Committee, North 24 Parganas;
2. Superintendent, Dhrubashram Observation Home.
