

Order Below Application for extension of Status quo order

1. The instant application is moved by the learned advocate for the plaintiff and thereby prayed for extension of “status quo” order until next date.
2. By way of this application it is the case of the applicant, in brief, that the instant matter is posted for arguments on temporary injunction application, however the defendant did not argue on the said application. Therefore the earlier order of status quo needs to be continued until decision on Exh.5 application. Hence, the instant of application for the relief sought for.
3. Though the say of defendants came to be called out, still none appeared on their behalf and also filed say. Thus, considering the nature of application vis-a-vis the urgency sought for, I have taken up this application for decision at once.
4. Admittedly the matter is posted for arguments on application for temporary injunction. Further, it is undisputed that on last date status-quo order has been continued and both parties have been directed to maintain status-quo. Today, the defendants are absent. They failed to argue on temporary injunction application. I have already considered the apprehension of alienation. According to the applicant the said apprehension still intact. Thus, only to avoid the multiplicity of litigation and change on the suit property, only upto next date the earlier order of status-quo needs to be extended. Hence, it is hereby extended until next date i.e. 15.09.2025. Both parties to take note. Order accordingly.
