1. Computer generated Statement of Account and Tax Invoices filed on behalf of plaintiff on 06.06.2026. Udyam Registration Certificate downloaded from its portal alongwith Certificate under section 63 of Bharatiya Sakshya Adhiniyam, 2023 filed on behalf of plaintiff today.

2. Plaintiff has filed the present suit under Order XXXVII CPC against defendants for seeking recovery of an amount of Rs.8,35,074.20/- alongwith pendente lite and future interest @ 24% per annum and cost of the suit.

3. The suit filed by plaintiff is accompanied by Statement of Truth, Non-Starter Report dated 17.04.2026/23.04.2026 and Court Fees.

4. As per the submissions made by counsel for plaintiff, **instant suit filed by plaintiff under Order XXXVII CPC is directed to be treated as an ordinary civil suit.**

5. Issue summons for settlement of issues to defendants at all the addresses given in the Memo of Parties, on taking of necessary steps by plaintiff within seven working days from today by all permissible modes, including dasti and electronic, returnable for **04.08.2026.**

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6. Summons upon defendants be served through District Judge of the district concerned within whose jurisdiction defendants have office or carrying on business or working for gain. Proof of service be furnished by plaintiff on or before the next date of hearing.

7. Defendants be informed to file written statement within a period of 30 days from the date of receipt of summons with advance copy to plaintiff and that filing of written statement in commercial suit in 120 days period is mandatory and no extension can be granted. A copy of order be also sent to defendants in terms of decision of Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in CM (M) (COMM) 136/2020 titled as *"North Delhi Municipal Corporation vs. M/s Dhingra Construction Company"*.
