Bhagyashri Vs. Sudhir & Ors.

Order Below Application for Issuance of Distress Warrant
(Passed on 30.04.2026)

1. Perused the e-filed record of the application. Perusal of the same reveals that the applicant has filed the present application and thereby requested to issue Distress Warrant against respondent No.1, since he failed to pay arrears of interim maintenance to the tune of Rs.1,15,000/-.
2. Perusal of the record reveals that the instant application was moved on last date. On that day respondent No.1 along with his advocate were present before the Court. The respondent had requested for some time to pay some amount out of the total arrears. Today none present for the respondent. Thus, it appears that despite having knowledge of the said order, the respondent herein is failed to comply with the same. Today he is absent when called repeatedly. Thus, it is observed that such neglecting and vagrant conduct at the instance of the respondent itself warrants issuance of distress warrant against him. Hence, issue distress warrant for arrears of interim maintenance amount of Rs.1,15,000/- against respondent No.1. Order accordingly.
