Ld. Counsel for plaintiff has moved an application under Order VI rule 17 of CPC seeking incorporation additional para no.8 and prayer clause in the plaint alongwith amended plaint and account statement of HDFC Bank showing the payment received by the plaintiff from the defendant in C.R. Park branch.

Considering the averments in the application and the amendment sought which are necessary for proper adjudication of the suit coupled with the facts that the suit is at initial state of summoning and the amendment sought will not change the nature of suit, therefore, in the interest of justice application under Order VI Rule 17 of CPC is allowed and account statement and amended plaint is taken on record in view of Order 11 of CCA.

Heard on the summoning.

Issue summons of the suit for settlement of issues to the defendant through all permissible modes on filing of PF and RC within two weeks, returnable for **02.07.2026**. The defendant be informed to file WS within a period of 30 days from the date of receipt of summons with advance copy to the plaintiff. A copy of the order be also sent to defendant in terms of the decision of Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in CM(M) No.136/2020 North Delhi Municipal Corporation vs. M/s Dhingra Construction Company.

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Ld. Counsel for the plaintiff is directed to file an affidavit affirming the e-mail address of the defendant under Rule 12 of Delhi Courts Services of process by courier, fax and electronic mail service (Civil Proceedings) Rule, 2010.

It terms of Rule 13, plaintiff is further directed to place on record a copy of the plaint and documents in electronic form/scanned image in compliance of Rule 13 for forwarding/annexing/attaching the same with the process. A requisite process fee for sending process by e-mail in compliance of Rule 14 be filed within a week alongwith copies as above for onward transmission to Nazarat Branch, Saket Courts for service through e-mail.
