Fresh claim petition received. It be checked and registered as per rule.

This is a fresh Claim Petition filed under Section 166 MV Act by injured persons, who suffered injuries in a road traffic accident, which allegedly **took place on 08.05.2025** due to rash and negligent driving of driver (R-1) of **vehicle bearing Registration no. HR38AG 4480.**

The offending vehicle is allegedly driven and owned by R-1 and insured with R-2.

Certified copy of entire criminal case record including case diary be filed, if not filed and status of DAR be notified by claimants.

Further, petitioner is at liberty to move appropriate application before the Ld. MACT, of the area where the accident took place, for calling, clubbing of such DAR and transferring the same to this Tribunal.

Heard Counsel for petitioners. Record perused.

Ld. Counsel for claimant seeks time to take requisite steps for impleadment of Nodal Officer of the insurance company of offending vehicle.

Let notice of the claim petition be issued to the respondent(s) on filing of PF/ RC/ Speed Post/ Authorised

courier and through electronic mode including email. *Dasti* notice be also given.

Directions for claimant(s)

In view of **Practice Directions bearing No. 134/Rules/DHC dated 14.05.2025**, claimants are directed to place on record the following documents/details, if not already filed:

- (i) Names and addresses (local and permanent) of the injured persons or the owners of the damaged property, as the case may be;
- (ii) Aadhar, PAN details and email-id, if any of the injured persons or the owners of the damaged property, as the case may be;
- (iii) Names and addresses (local and permanent) of all the legal representatives of the deceased victim of the accident who are claiming compensation, their Aadhar and PAN details and email-id, if any;
- (iv) Bank account details along with either a certificate of the banker giving all details of the bank account of the person or persons entitled to receive the compensation including IFS Code, or a copy of a cancelled cheque of the bank account.
- (v) Updating information regarding the bank accounts, email id, in case there is any change;
- (vi) Two sets of photographs and specimen signatures of the claimant(s).

Put up for further proceedings on **25.07.2026**. Tracking report be filed.
