**ORDER BELOW EXH.115 IN
REGULAR CIVIL SUIT NO.191/2015
ASHOKAPPA VS. BHAGWAN & ORS.**

1. This is an application under Order VI Rule 17 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 for amendment of plaint.
2. Read the application and say filed thereon. Heard the Learned Advocate for both sides.
3. The suit is for declaration of ownership and perpetual injunction. Plaintiff has not yet opened his evidence. Perusal of proposed amendment shows that it is minor typographical mistake. It is seen that the proposed amendment is of formal in nature and the same will not cause substantial change in the pleadings of the plaintiff and no prejudice would be caused to the defendants, if the application is allowed.
