On this application order passed subject to non challenge of the identity of accused later on.

Deposition of witness No.5 for prosecution

Examination-in-chief by APP Mr. S.S. Kulkarni for State -

On 25/02/2016 I was practicing as Medical Officer at PHC Shirur Anantpal. On that day, Bandu Ramrao Mohite and Shesherao Ramrao Mohite came to hospital alongwith police yadi for treatment. I have taken identification marks, Bandu shows black mole over back and face and Shesherao shows black mole over back and face. I have examined Bandu Ramrao Mohite and found following injuries sustained to Bandu Mohite,-

1. CLW over head which having irregular margin of size of 3X1X0.5 c.m., nature of injury is simple, age of injury less than 24 hours and weapon hard and blunt object.

2. Contusion over right leg with irregular margins of size of 2X1 c.m., nature of injury is simple, age of injury less than 24 hours and weapon hard and blunt object.

2] Thereafter, I have also examined Shesherao Ramrao Mohite and found following injuries sustained to Shesherao Mohite,-

1. Contusion over head with irregular margins of size of 2X1 c.m., nature of injury is simple, age of injury less than 24 hours and weapon hard and blunt object.

2. Contusion over left shoulder with irregular margins of size of 2X1 c.m., nature of injury is simple, age of injury less than 24 hours and weapon hard and blunt object.

2] Accordingly, I issued injury certificates of patients. It bears my signature and seal of PHC Shirur Anantpal. The contents in the medical certificates is true and correct. It is marked as **Exh.69 and**

70. Today, I brought the original MLC register with me which discloses treatment taken by patient in PHC Shirur Anantpal. Now, I have shown axe and sickle having wooden handle. The above stated injuries are possible with the help of handle of weapon and not with the sharp edge of axe and sickle.

Examination-in-chief is over.

Cross-examination by Adv. A.S. Makne for accused

3] It is true to say that, both certificates at Exh.69 and 70 does not shows the time when patients came to the hospital. I have inquired about the previous health issues of patient. It is true to say that, injuries to Bandu Mohite possible if person false from motorcycle on road. It is true to say that, injury No.1 to Shesherao Mohite not specifically mentioned on which part of the head injury sustained. It is true to say that, injury No.2 to Shesherao Mohite possible if he false on road by slipping. Patients told me history of assault. Weapon axe and sickle comes within the purview of blunt object. It is not true to say that, due to absence of time on injury certificate, exact age of injury cannot be stated. It is not true to say that, above injuries stated by me to patients Bandu and Shesherao was not sustained due to the handle of axe and sickle. It is not true to say that, patients not told me about the injuries caused with the handle of axe and sickle. It is not true to say that I have not examined patients and issued false injury certificate.
