

Accused no.2 & 3 are absent. Ld. Adv. for accused filed application at Exh.72 and prayed that he is ready to examine witness in absence of accused and he will not challenge the identity of the accused. On this application order passed subject to non challenge of the identity of accused later on.

Deposition of witness No.3 for prosecution

I do hereby on solemn affirmation state as under :

Examination-in-chief by APP Mr. S.R. Kulkarni for State -

On 10/06/2021, I was working as a Medical Officer at PHC Ambulga. On that day, at about 5:00 PM, a patient, namely Dattatray Jagnath Jadhav, was brought to PHC Ambulga with a police yadi and a history of alleged assault.

The patient had a mole on his left forearm. I examined the patient and found the following injuries:

1. Lacerated wound over the left parietal region of the head, with irregular margins and an oblique direction, measuring 6×1 cm, skin deep. The injury was simple in nature, caused by a hard and blunt object, and was within 24 hours old.
2. Lacerated wound over the sagittal region of the head, with irregular margins and an oblique direction, measuring 5×1 cm, skin deep. The injury was simple in nature, caused by a hard and blunt object, and was

within 24 hours old.

3. Abrasion near the right ring finger, with irregular margins and an oblique direction, measuring 1 cm. The injury was simple in nature, caused by a hard and blunt object, and was within 24 hours old.

02. Accordingly, I issued the injury certificate of the patient. It bears my signature and the seal of PHC Ambulga. The contents of the injury certificate are true and correct. Hence, the injury certificate is marked as **Exhibit 74**. The letter issued by Police Station Aurad Shahajani, which I received on 10 June 2021, is true and correct. Hence, it is marked as **Exhibit 75**. Today, I have brought the original MLC record with me. I have been shown the iron rod marked as Article-A. The injuries mentioned above are possible with a weapon such as the said iron rod.

Examination-in-chief is over.

Cross-Examination by Adv. G. R. Salunkhe for the Accused

03. I did not record the name of the person who allegedly assaulted the patient. Above the three injuries mentioned above, Injury Nos. 1 and 2 were on the head. If a person falls on the road, the nature of the injuries would depend upon the manner in which the person falls. If an assault is committed with the iron rod (Article-A), there is a possibility of causing grievous injuries. It is not true to say that the injuries mentioned above are not possible by the use of the iron rod marked as Article-A. It is true that Exhibit 74

does not mention the name of the doctor who examined the patient.

Question: Exhibit 74 does not bear your name anywhere. Therefore, did you not examine the patient?

Answer: I have signed the certificate. I have also produced the original MLC register.

Question: When did you sign the certificate at Exhibit 74?

Answer: I did not mention the date below my signature.

It is true that **Exhibit 74** does not mention the name of the police station to which the certificate was issued. It is also true that Exhibit 74 does not mention the date on which the certificate was issued. It is not true to suggest that I did not examine the patient, namely Dattatray Jagnath Jadhav. There were two Medical Officers posted at PHC Ambulga. It is not true to suggest that I did not know the patient, Dattatray Jagnath Jadhav. It is not true to suggest that I issued a false medical certificate without examining the patient. It is not true to suggest that I am deposing falsely in order to help the complainant. It is not true to suggest that I have falsely stated that the injuries are possible by the use of Article-A.

Cross-examination is over.
