The charge-sheet is filed under Section 65(e) of the Bombay Prohibition Act. For several times summons issued to accused. But accused not traced. The police machinery was failed to caught the accused. Upon perusal of record, it appears that, CA report not received till date. In this circumstances, it is not proper that case should be kept pending for presence of the accused in near future. No purpose would be served by keeping the matter pending for presence of accused. Therefore, I am of opinion that this is fit case to inclined power under section 281 of the Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita. Hence, I proceed to pass the following order-

**ORDER**

01.	Case is stopped against accused under Section 281 of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita subject to Section 337(5) of the Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita.
02.	The accused is discharged from the offence punishable under section 65(e) of the Bombay Prohibition Act vide Section 281 of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita.
03.	Bail bonds of the accused is cancelled.
04.	The seized muddemal is worthless, be disposed of as per rules.
