3. Whether the plaintiff proves that the Sale Deed bearing day book No. 815/2022 executed by defendant No. 1 in favour of defendant No. 8 and the Sale Deed bearing day book No. 960/2024 executed in favour of defendant No. 7 by defendant No. 1 & 8 are illegal and not binding on her share ?
4. Whether the defendant No. 1, 5, 6 & 7 prove that suit property is self acquired property of defendant No. 1 ?
5. Whether the suit is barred by non-joinder of necessary party and non-joinder of all ancestral property in common hotchpot ?
6. What order and decree ?
