The accused is charged with the offence punishable under section 65(e) of Maharashtra Prohibition Act. The record reveals that time to time summons and warrant are issued to the accused. There is no Chemical Analyzer report on record. Therefore, even with the evidence of other witnesses, accused is liable to be acquitted. There is no point in keeping the case pending any more. Hence, the order.

ORDER

- 1- The proceeding is stopped u/s.281 of the Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita.
- 2- Accused stands discharged.
- 3- His bail bond stands cancelled.
- 4- Seized muddemal i.e. 45x180 ml. bottles Macdol no.1 be sent to the office of Superintendent, State Excise, Latur Division, Latur for disposal as per law.
