JUDGMENT
(Delivered On 13.03.2026)

The accused are charged for the offence punishable under Section 12A of Maharashtra Prevention of Gambling Act.

Brief facts of the case are as follows :

Today accused are present before me. They plead guilty. Then I made them aware about the consequences of plead guilty even though they want to plead guilty. Accepted their plead guilty as voluntarily one. I stop here to hear the accused on the point of quantum of sentence. The accused have prayed for leniency submitting that, They are poor persons and their entire family depends upon them. Considering the nature and circumstances of offence, I pass the following order :

ORDER

1. Accused no.1 Dnyaneshwar Naryan Madke, 2. Govind Shankar Vir, are convicted for the offence punishable under Section 12A of Maharashtra Prevention of Gambling Act vide Section 275 of the Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita and sentenced of till the rising of the Court and to pay fine of Rs. 300/- (Rs. Three Hundred) each in default to suffer simple imprisonment for three days.
