

Order below exh. 1 in Civil M. A. No.335/2025

Applicants have filed the present application under Section 2 of the Bombay Regulation Act, VII, 1827 for Heirship Certificate of Late – Arjun Narayan Shivankar.

2] **Brief facts of the applicants case:**

The applicant No. 1 is wife and other applicant's are children of deceased person namely Arjun Narayan Shivankar. Deceased person Arjun Narayan Shivankar is died on 09.09.2020 at Harwadi, Tal- Renapur, Dist- Latur. Applicants are in need of heirship certificate for Government purpose. Except applicants there is no legal heirs of deceased Arjun Narayan Shivankar. Therefore, applicants applied to grant of heirship certificate for Government Purpose.

3] Accordingly, citation notice and paper publication was issued, but no one has taken any objection.

4] The following are the points which arose for my determination along-with my findings thereon.

:- REASONS:-

As to Point No. 1 and 2 :-

5] In order to substantiate their claim, applicant No. 2 Tukaram Shivankar (AW 1) has filed his evidence-affidavits at Exh.12. After issuance of proclamation and citation nobody has taken the objection to grant heirship certificate in favour of the applicants.

6] The applicants have also relied on various documentary evidences. A] Copy of death certificate of deceased Arjun Narayan Shivankar, B]

Photocopies of adharcard of applicant, other legal heirs and deceased, C] Paper notice published in the newspaper "Vishwauday" dtd. 01.11.2025 at Exh.11, D] Proclamation report at Exh.07.

07] From the perusal of evidence affidavit of applicant and documents produced by applicant and considering the ground that, nobody has objected to issue the heirship certificate to applicant, it appears that, applicants are heirs of the said deceased person. Claim of the applicants stands un rebutted. Thus, I have no hesitation to grant Heirship Certificate in favour of the applicant. Hence, I answer point no.1 in affirmative & I proceed to pass following order.

:- O R D E R :-

- 1] Application is allowed.
- 2] Issue Heirship Certificate under Bombay Regulation Act, VIII, 1827 of deceased namely – Arjun Narayan Shivankar in favour of the applicants namely Rajashree Arjun Shivankar, Tukaram Arjun Shivankar and Dnyaneshwari Gajanan Aarsul on deposit of requisite court fee stamp.
- 3] Applicant to bear his own costs.
