**Order below exh. 1**

Applicants have filed the present application under Section 2 of the Bombay Regulation Act, VII, 1827 for Heirship Certificate of Late – Dnyaneshwar Bhagwan Sude.

2] Brief facts of the applicants case:

The applicant No.1 is wife, applicant No.2 is daughter and other legal heirs Chandrakala is mother of deceased person Dnyaneshwar Bhagwan Sude. The deceased person died on 12.10.2023 at village Patharwadi Tq.Renapur, Dist.Latur. Therefore, except applicants there is no legal heirs of deceased person. Therefore, applicants applied to grant of heirship certificate.

3] Accordingly, citation notice and paper publication was issued, but no one has taken any objection.

4] The following are the points which arose for my determination along-with my findings thereon.

**-: REASONS:-**

**As to Point No. 1 and 2 :-**

5] In order to substantiate their claim, applicant no.1 Akshata ( AW 1 ) has filed her evidence-affidavits at Exh.14. Nobody has taken the objection to grant heirship certificate in favour of the applicants.

6] The applicants have also relied on various documentary evidences. A] Copy of death certificate of deceased Dnyaneshwar Bhagwan Sude at Exh.4/1, B] Verified copies of adharcard of applicants, C] Paper notice published in the newspaper "Vishwauday" dtd.30/11/2025 at Exh.13, D] Proclamation report at Exh.17.

07] From the perusal of evidence affidavit of applicant and documents produced by applicants and considering the ground that, nobody has objected to issue the heirship certificate to applicants, it appears that, applicants are legal heirs of the said deceased person. Claim of the applicant stands un rebutted. Thus, I have no hesitation to grant Heirship Certificate in favour of the applicants. Hence, I answer point no.1 in affirmative & I proceed to pass following order.

**:- O R D E R :-**

- 1] Application is allowed.
- 2] Issue Heirship Certificate under Bombay Regulation Act, VIII, 1827 of deceased namely - Late Dnyaneshwar Bhagwan Sude in favour of the applicants namely Akshada Dnyaneshwar Sude, Adhira Dnyaneshwar Sude, Chandrakala Bhagwan Sude on deposit of requisite court fee stamp.
- 3] Applicants to bear their own costs.
