Case is called out. The plaintiff is present along with her respective Adv. A.S. More, the defendant is also present with his Adv. D.D. Hipparkar. Perused record and proceeding. It appears that, the suit is exclusively for perpetual injunction.

2] The plaintiff and defendant have filed compromise jointly at Exh.10. Read the joint compromise at Exh.09. The parties are admitted the contents of same and hence, it is read and recorded. Thus, it appears that, present suit is amicably settled between the parties. The suit is therefore, disposed of as compromised. In view of compromise, the decree be drawn up exclusively, to the extent of perpetual injunction. The decree will take effect after registration as per procedure. Therefore no order as to costs.
