



ORDER BELOW EXH.01 IN R.C.S. NO. 272/2026
(Gafar Vs. Maheboob)

Case is called out. The plaintiff is present along with her respective Adv. N.G. Lohare, the defendant is also present with her Adv. G.H. Kusumkar. Perused record and proceeding. It appears that the suit is exclusively for perpetual injunction.

2. The plaintiff and defendant had filed compromise pursis jointly. Read the joint compromise pursis at Exh.10. The parties are admitted the contents of same and hence it is read and recorded. Thus, it appears that, present suit is amicably settled between the parties. The suit is therefore, disposed of as compromised. In view of compromise pursis, the decree be drawn up exclusively, to the extent of perpetual injunction. The decree will take effect after registration as per procedure. Therefore no order as to costs.
