



Cri.M.A.No. 53/2019

Order passed below Exh.13 i

1. This is an application filed by applicant for medical expenses.
2. Perused application, say and record.
3. Heard advocate Shri Mhetre for applicant and Shri Sayyed for non-applicant.
4. On perusing affidavit and application it appears that the applicant prayed Rs.90,000/- for her medical treatment. The medical quotations produced by applicant which shows that, the applicant needed Rs.90,000/- for her medical expenses.
5. The non-applicant contended that, the excess amount prayed by applicant. The advocate for non-applicant and non-applicant present before Court. They made statement that Rs.35,000/- to Rs.40,000/- are sufficient for the medical expenses of applicant.
6. Considering situation I conclude that the applicant needed money for her medical treatment. The non-applicants have not denied

medical treatment. Therefore, it is necessary to grant medical expenses to applicant from non-applicant.

7. The salary certificate of non-applicant produced by applicant. It shows that, non-applicant received Rs.32,370/- as salary per month.

8. The say of non-applicant shows that, he has having other liabilities. Considering all above circumstances in my view Rs.50,000/- is sufficient amount for medical expenses of applicant which are mentioned in document at Exh.12/2 and 12/3. In these circumstances, I pass following order.

ORDER

1. Application is partly allowed.
2. The non-applicant No.1 do pay Rs.50,000/- to the applicant No.1 for her medical expenses mentioned in Exh.12/2 and 12/3 within three weeks from today.
3. No order as to cost.
