

Common Order below Exhs.80 to 82

Learned advocate Shri. M.B. Biradar submitted that the accused No.1 was ill and accused No.3, 4, 6 and 7 are ready to abide conditions and pay minimum amount in respect of forfeiting of bail bond, in the event of release on fresh bail. He prayed to cancellation of proclamation and release accused on fresh bail. Learned APP has opposed these applications and prayed to pass appropriate order.

2. I have carefully perused the record and applications. The reason of illness of accused No.1 is supported by documents. But the reason of absence of accused is general and well within their control. The accused tried to prolong the matter and their Advocate failed to proceed with case without reasonable cause. As issued NBW and proclamation under Section 84 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita against accused and arrested them among to forfeit their bail bond.

3. But the accused are ready to proceed further and attend the case on each and every date. The accused No.2 and 5 have filed undertaking (Exh.65 and 66) in that support. The offences are triable by this Court. Considering aforesaid reason and submission, the proclamation can be cancelled and release the accused on bail bond. However, the penalty for breach of bail bond can be remitted upto Rs.3000/- each. Considering nature of offence and

submission of expedite the case, the accused are entitled to fresh bail. In the result I pass following order-

ORDER

1. The applications are allowed in the interest of justice on following terms:-

1) The proclamation and NBW against accused No.1, 3, 4, 6 and 7 shall be cancelled subject to penalty Rs.3000/- each.

2) The accused No.1, 3, 4, 6 and 7 shall execute fresh bail bond Rs.15,000/- each and furnish surety bond in like amount.

3) The accused No.1, 3, 4, 6 and 7 shall attend the case on every date and proceed with the case without claiming adjournment.

4) The accused shall furnish details of their permanent address and contact number alongwith two relatives.
