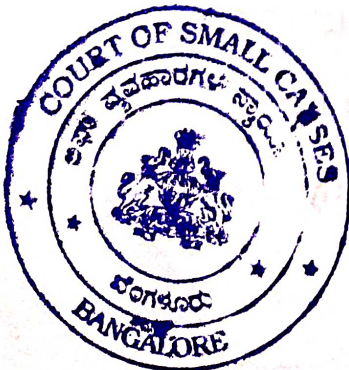

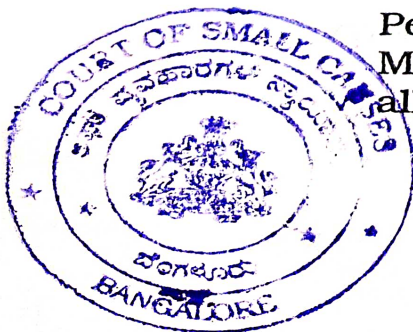

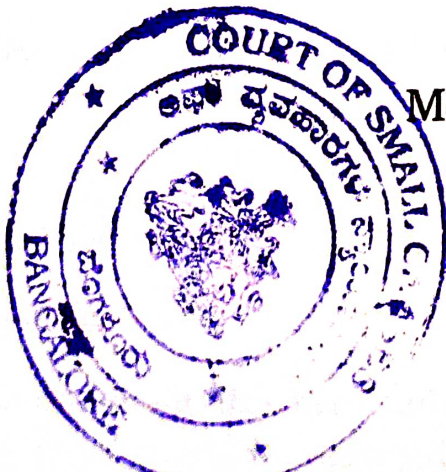
The Petitioners are entitled for compensation amount of **Rs.20,85,600/-** (Rupees twenty lakhs, eighty five thousand and six hundred only) with interest @ **6% p.a.**, from the date of petition till its realization.

The Respondent No.1 & 2 are jointly and severally liable to pay compensation to the Petitioners. Further, Respondent No.1/Insurance Company is directed to deposit the compensation amount together with 6% interest within **60 days** from the date of this Order.

After deposit, out of total compensation amount **50% each** with interest shall be released in favour of the Petitioner No.1 and 2 with proper identification and the remaining amount of **50% each** with interest shall be deposited in FD in their names in any nationalized bank of their choice, for a period of **Three years**, with a liberty to withdraw accrued interest periodically.

Advocate fee is fixed at Rs.1,000/-.
