

ORDER BELOW EXH.13 IN L.A.R. DARKHAST NO.366/2019.
(OLD L.A.R. DARKHAST NO.2244/1990)
BHANUDAS KAMBLE VS. STATE AND OTHERS.
CNR NO.MHLA170028522023.

The decree holder has filed application submitting the inadvertently name of his is written as 'Amruta' instead of 'Amrita'. Therefore, he may be granted permission to correct the name of his father in the title clause of the darkhast.

2] Judgment debtor Nos.1 and 2 failed to file their say. Hence, "No-say" order is passed against them.

3] It is clear from the provisions of Order-VI Rule-17 of Code of Civil Procedure that the Court may at any stage of the proceeding allow any party to alter or amend its pleadings and such amendment shall be necessary for purpose of determining the real question in controversy between the parties. In the present application the decree holder wants to correct the name of his father by insertin name as 'Amrita' instead of 'Amruta'allowing the application will not change the nature of the darkhast. No prejudice will be caused Judgment debtors. Therefore, the application is liable to be allowed. Hence, I pass following order :-

ORDER

- 1] The application is allowed.
- 2] The decree holder is granted permission to insert the name of his father as 'Amrita' instead of 'Amruta' in the title clause of the darkhast. He shall carry out the amendment in the darkhast accordingly within 14 days from this order.
- 3] No order as to costs.
