Naziya Parveen -vs- M/s. Jay Agency & others

Instant application has been filed by the non-applicant no.2 for direction to the applicant to supply translated copy of police papers filed on record. It is submitted that the aforesaid is fixed today before this Court for written statement of non-applicant. But on today, non-applicant no.2 unable to file written statement on record due to all the police papers and documents are in the Telugu language. This language could not understand, therefore the learned Counsel for non-applicant no.2 could not produce written statement. Therefore, prayed to give direction to the applicant to supply the translated copy of police papers and other documents which are in Telugu language. Hence, prayed to allow the application.

02. The learned Counsel of applicant has given say on rear side of the application and strongly opposed the application. It is submitted that the summons to this non-applicant served on 02.3.2020 but till this date written statement is not filed. Already mandatory period of filing written statement lapsed. So far as, translated copy of police paper, the non-applicant cannot insist and if required will file at the time of evidence for the purpose

of Court. Hence, the application is not having legal force. Therefore, prayed to reject the application.

03. Perused the application and say. Heard both the parties. The application shows that the no-applicant intending to direction to the applicant to supply the translated copy of police papers and other documents which are in Telugu language. Perusal of the record, it appears that along with the main application, applicant filed various documents on record, out of which document nos.9 & 10 i. e. FIR and some part of crime detail form are in Telugu Language. Therefore, as the said documents are in the Telugu language, it is necessary to file the translated copy of the said documents on record. Therefore, in order to decide the real controversy between the parties, it is necessary to file translated copy of the said documents. Therefor, in the interest of justice and in order to decide the matter on merit, this application needs to be allowed. Hence, I pass the following order.

ORDER

- 1) Application is allowed.
- 2) Applicant is directed to file the translated copy of the police papers which are in Telugu language.
