This is an application filed by the Non-applicant for setting-aside no cross order dated 16.04.2025 passed against them and grant permission for cross-examination of applicant. It is submitted that today the instant matter is fixed for evidence of non-applicant. There is no ill intention of non-applicant to not to remain present for cross examination of applicant but due to ill ness of the counsel of non-applicant, not remain present before the court and therefore, the order is passed against them. Lastly, prayed to set-aside the no cross-examination order dated 16.04.2025 passed against them.

02. The applicant has given say on this application and strongly opposed the application. It is further submitted that non-applicant deliberately and in order to prolong the matter not remain present before the court for his cross-examination. Lastly, prayed to reject the application.

03. Heard both the parties. Perused record.

04. On perusal of the record, it appears that the reason assigned by the non-applicant for not remain present before the court for cross-examination of applicant is appeared to be

convincing and genuine. Under such circumstances, it would be justified to give one more opportunity to non applicant for cross-examination of applicant. But considering the delay on the part of non-applicant some cost needs to be imposed on non-applicant. In the result, I pass the following order.

ORDER

- 1) Application is allowed subject to cost of 200/- paid to the applicant on or before next date.
- 2) Non-applicant is directed that after depositing the cost amount on next date conduct cross-examination of applicant on next date positively.
