11.08.2026 A surrender cum bail petition, dt. 11.08.2026, has been filed on behalf of accused petitioner namely **Krishna Murari Bharti @ Murari Bharti, S/o Jagdish Bharti**, moved today. Copy of the same has already been served to the Ld. APP. Accused petitioner is taken into judicial custody.

The learned counsel of the petitioner has submitted that having learnt about the requirements in this case, the petitioner above named is voluntarily surrendering and praying for regular bail. The petitioner had been enlarged on bail by the order of this learned court dt. 15.01.2022, except the aforesaid bail petition, there is no bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been filed by the petitioner either before the Sessions Court or the Hon'ble High Court. The petitioner is quite innocent and he has not committed any offence. He has been falsely implicated in this case. The petitioner has not deliberately misused the liberty granted by this learned court. The pairvikar of the petitioner does not do pairvi on behalf of the petitioner due to confusion of dates. He could not physically attend the court on stipulated dates. Thus, this learned court was pleased enough and cancelled the previous bail granted to the petitioner vide its order dt. 19.05.2026. The petitioner undertakes to be attended in the court regularly in future. The petitioner case is counterblast vide Chhattarpur PS Case No. 285/2020 corresponding to Gr Case No. 664/2022 under sections 279, 337, 338 of the IPC against the informant namely Vikash Kumar Dubey, which is pending in the court of Smt. Samirah Khan, JM 1st class, Palamau at Daltonganj. There is no chance of absconding or tampering with the evidence by the petitioner of

this case. There is no criminal antecedent against the petitioner. The petitioner is ready to abide by all the terms and conditions fixed by the court. Lastly, he prayed to allow the present bail petition.

Ld. APP has opposed the prayer of bail.

Heard both the side and perused the case record. From perusal of the case record it transpires that the case was fixed on 19.06.2026 for statement of accused person and he was not physically present before the court. Hence, his bail was canceled and order to issue NBW against him was passed vide order dt. 19.06.2026. Today, petitioner surrendered voluntarily and is ready to abide by all terms and conditions of this court. The misuse of bail is not intentional and there is misuse of only one date.

Hence, considering the above facts and circumstances, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner, named above, on bail, on furnishing bail bond of **Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties** with condition that he will appear physically till the disposal of this case.

Accordingly, MCA No. 4132/2026 is disposed of.
