Examination in chief for the accused by learned Advocate Shri. Prkash Ganage holding for Shri. Raut :-

1. I know Mangesh parab. As we resident of same colony. I know Anil Dhamale who is resident of same building and colony.

2. Mangesh met with an accident at the night time. Then we went to Global Hospital. Anil Dhamale deposited Rs.25,000/- at the hospital as deposit. On second day we went there. I could not go upstairs. Anil Dhamale his relative Kadam, myself and Umesh Kadam had discussion. It was discussed that the hospitalized person had mediclaim of Rs. 5 lacs. It was discussed that if the bill amount exceeds Rs.5 lac then such surplus bill would be paid by Anil and compensation of Rs.50,000/- for post hospitalization. Then we visited Bhoiwada court and prepared one affidavit. The affidavit was prepared on 24th July. I was the witness for the same. I don't know what happened afterwards.

Learned advocate for the accused submits that chief examination is completed.

Cross Examination for the complainant by learned Advocate Shri. A.A.Mir :-

3. Not true to say that no such affidavit was prepared on 24th July.

Question- The declaration with regard to enhancement of the medical treatment expenses was executed on 30th July 2021 on the basis of which the accused issued the cheque of Rs. 1 lac ?

Answer- I was not present and I have no concern about the same. Not true to say that I did not visit the hospital nor such discussion took



place in my presence. Not true to say that I have no knowledge about the dispute. Not true to say that I have deposed false as the accused is my friend.

Learned advocate for the complainant submits that the cross examination is completed.

Learned advocate for the accused submits that re examination is not required.
