

ORDER BELOW EXH. 1

Perused the complaint, verification and heard Learned Counsel for the complainant. A partner of the complainant firm namely Mr. Anil Vijay Deshmukh stated that the accused assaulted the Director of the complainant firm. It appears that entire incident occurred with the Director of the complainant firm. Therefore, the evidence of Mr. Anil Vijay Deshmukh is not sufficient to issue process against the accused and on the basis of his evidence no *prima facie* case is made out. Therefore, for the interest of justice, issue process will have to be postponed and the complainant will have to be given an opportunity to lead evidence as per Section 202 of the Code of Criminal Procedure. Hence, the order :-

ORDER

The complainant is directed to lead evidence as per Section 202 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
