This case referred to the Lok Adalat organized by Tirupur Taluk Legal Services Committee Under Section 19 of Legal Services Authorities Act (39/1987) coming on before us for endeavors at settlement of the dispute between the parties, being the subject matter of this case, in the presence of the parties and their counsel, and after a full and frank discussion of all issues factual and legal arising from the case, the parties having agreed before us that there shall be an award/order/decreed in



Settlement hereto made and the parties and their counsel herein having, in acceptance of the same signed this in our presence, it is decreed/ordered.

Both parties are present. On negotiation, both parties have agreed for settlement of the dispute for a sum of Rs. 18,60,000/-

The Petitioners are entitled to the compensation amount in the following ratio.

1st petitioner share amount is Rs. 10,00,000/-

2nd petitioner share amount is Rs. 4,30,000/-

3rd petitioner share amount is Rs. 4,30,000/-

The respondent is directed to deposit the settled amount before the Exclusive Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Tirupur court within six weeks from the date of this award, failing which the respondent agreed to pay interest 7.5% per annum on the award amount from today till the date of deposit.

The dispute between the parties is settled accordingly. Therefore, the award is passed in accordance with the sections 21/22 E of Legal Services Authorities Act 1987.

As and when the award amount is deposited in the court, the same shall be disbursed to the petitioner/s through NEFT/RTGS, as per the directions of the High Court of Madras, in CMA.No.428/2016, in the bank account of the petitioner/s as given below:
