RC receipt dated 29.06.2026 placed on record by the counsel for the complainant as per which statutory period of 30 days giving rise to presumption of due service has elapsed but the accused has not come present before the court. Thus, the court is satisfied that the accused despite having knowledge of the pendency of the present case is intentionally avoiding service and not appearing in the court. The legislature has contemplated that trial of offence u/s 25 of Payment and Settlement Act is to be completed within period of six months. Accordingly, the court is satisfied that the accused cannot be served through ordinary process and coercive steps needs to be taken to procure presence of the accused. As such, the accused is ordered to be served through **bailable warrants** in the sum of Rs. 5000/- with one surety in the like amount for **30.10.2026**. The complainant is permitted to accompany the serving constable in execution of bailable warrants.
