3. Do the defendant no.1 to 4 prove the partition of suit schedule properties by way of registered partition deed dated: 12.06.1961 during the life time of their father as alleged in para no. 7 of the WS?
4. Do the defendant no.1 to 4 prove that the plaintiff has relinquished her rights by receiving cash and gold at the time of the marriage as alleged in para no.7of the WS?
5. To what shares the defendants are entitled?
6. To what relief the parties are entitled?
7. What order or decree?
