**COMMON ORDER BELOW BAIL APPLICATIONS**

Perused bail application and say. Heard both side. Accused Nos. 2 and 3 are charged for the offence punishable U/Secs.204, 205, 319(2), 318(4), 336(2), 338, 336(3), 340(2), 61(2) of BNS 2023 and 66(c) and 66(d) of Information Technology Act. Accused are in custody since 17.04.2026. Allegation against the accused are that, they have committed Cyber fraud of Rs.60,00,000/-. The role of accused Nos. 2 and 3 is that they have received only Rs.2,00,000/- out of the 60,00,000/-. Accused Nos. 2 and 3 have returned Rs.2,00,000/- to the complainant today. The complainant has filed pursis in that behalf and filed her say that, she has no objection to their bail application. In view of this fact, accused Nos. 2 and 3 are entitled for enlarged on bail with following order -

**ORDER**

1. Accused Nos. 2 and 3 are released on furnishing P. B. and S.B. of Rs.7,500/-each (Rupees Seven Thousand Five Hundred only each). Deposit of cash bail of Rs.7,500/-each is allowed for next four weeks. (Rupees Seven Thousand Five Hundred only each).
2. Accused to submit his address proof.
3. Accused shall not tamper the evidence and shall not pressurize the prosecution witnesses.
4. Accused shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court till conclusion of the trial.

5. Accused shall not misuse the liberty.
6. Intimation of this order be send to accused immediately through the Superintendent of Jail.
