

ORDER BELOW MAIN COMPLAINT AT EXH. 1

This instant matter pertains to a complaint duly filed under the provisions of **Section 210(1)(a), read with Section 2(h)** of the **Bharatiya Nagarika Suraksha Sanhita, 2023** (hereinafter referred to as 'the Sanhita'). Before this Court proceeds to adjudicate upon the merits of the complaint, specifically in order to ascertain:

- (a) Whether the complaint warrants the **issuance of process** against the proposed accused, as stipulated under Section 227 of the Sanhita;
 - (b) Whether the complaint merits **dismissal** under the provisions of Section 226 of the Sanhita; or,
 - (c) Whether the complaint ought to be **returned for want of territorial or pecuniary jurisdiction**, as contemplated by Section 224 of the Sanhita,
- it is incumbent upon this Court to comply with the mandatory requirement of issuing notice to the proposed accused/respondent. This requirement is prescribed by the **First Proviso to Sub-section (1) of Section 223 of the Sanhita**.

Accordingly, let a **mandatory notice** be issued to the proposed accused/respondent in this matter. This measure is essential to ensure that the proposed accused/respondent is afforded the fundamental opportunity of **being heard**, thereby adhering to the principles of natural justice.

Hence, **issue notice to the respondent, returnable on the next date of hearing.**
